HFT – New Targets Are Rocking:

We have now purchased lots of new targets for the outdoor HFT shoots, and July/Aug saw their first introduction to replace the traditional knockdown targets. Judging by some of the scores posted they definitely seem to be going down well with all and so far work really well.

These new targets do not have a string attached, instead they rock on a curved base, hitting the kill zone would cause the inner target to spin on its bar making it a lot easier to see if you have a kill or just a hit, especially for those older box targets where you would hear the “ting” of metal and left unsure if you hit the box or earnt a point.

Not only are they great fun as its very satisfying to see them spin but it makes life a lot easier for those setting up /clearing away as they simply sit on a base, no securing down, no strings to unravel etc.
