This was a new event to cover all 3 aspects/disciplines of Monday night shoots. We did 2 rounds of Rifle, 2 rounds of Pistol onto Paper target followed by 1 round (3 mags) of speed shooting. The final results were based on overall positions from each discipline, so you needed to fair well in all 3 to get a podium.

The format 1 sighter and 6 shots scoring, with the top 7 shooters of the team going towards the final team score. On this leg Hinckley beat Redhill 192 Points to 180.

The 2nd leg was in June at the Queen Vic and was our usual format (4 rounds of 6 shots), again top 7 shooter score going towards final team score. On this return leg Redhill won by 30 points, meaning the overall winners across both legs was Redhill Revolvers. As well as the shoot there was also good banter and hot food put on by both parties. Overall, 2 good nights was had by all and both teams are looking forward to many more matches in the future, as well as Redhill Vs other local clubs once arranged.
